- 6. The officer of the deck must note the date, time, place, distance of importance or interest.
- 7. The name and rank of the commanding officer and the names and ranks of all officers and crew shall be recorded in front of Deck Log.
- 8. The "Record of Absence" shall be recorded in the Deck Log.
- 9. The time of departure and arrival at each port shall be recorded in the Deck Log.
- 10. In this statement symbols shall be indicated by the symbols.
- 11. When vessel is under way, all data applicable shall be recorded.
- 12. The first three columns shall be filled in. The remaining columns shall be left blank.
